Roland & Anna Houle Memorial Scholarship / Bursary

Our Lady of Guadalupe (OLG) Parish, Dartmouth, in partnership with St Peter Knights of Columbus Council 3133, have established a scholarship and bursary program in memory of, and funded by the estates of the late Roland and Anna Houle.

"Rollie" (1928 - 1987) and "Anne" (1928 - 2020) were committed and longtime members of the former St. Peter Parish community. They believed strongly in education as a means of developing potential and talent, and for achieving goals in one's personal life.

Non-renewable scholarships/ bursaries will be awarded annually based on applicants' academic standing and financial need. The 'standard' award is \$1000, but the financial value and number of awards granted in any given year may vary, dependent on available funds.

Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish was formally established in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia in December 2019. It resulted from the amalgamation of the former parishes of St. Anthony / St. Faustina Mission, Immaculate Conception, St Paul and St. Peter.

St Peter Knights of Columbus Council 3133 was established in 1948. It has continually and faithfully served the Order, former St. Peter Parish, and more recently OLG Parish, and the surrounding community since that time.





Qualifications & Regulations

 Open to Catholic students currently enrolled in Nova Scotia Grade 12, or 1st year university, college, or community college.

- 2. Applicants must be attending, or planning on attending a post-secondary institution in the same calendar year the scholarship/ bursary application is submitted.
- 3. Awards are based on academic performance and financial need. Parish, community and extracurricular school activities are also important factors.
- 4. Scholarship/ bursary awards are tenable at any legally recognized Canadian university, college, or community college beyond the secondary level.
- The financial value and number of awards granted in any given year may vary, dependent on available funds.
- Funds will be disbursed in January 2025, Upon confirmation of 2nd term enrollment.
- Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish and St Peter Knights of Columbus Council 3133 reserve the right to abandon or modify the scholarship/bursary program in the event circumstances render the continuance of the program impractical.

 - At least one letter of reference from an appropriate school official.
 - An <u>official transcript</u> (photocopies not accepted) of marks as follows: For students in Grade 12 – final Grade 11 marks & all available Grade 12 marks. For students in 1st year postsecondary institution – all high school final marks & all available post-secondary marks.
 - A letter of reference from the applicant's parish priest, deacon, or other official parish representative.
 - iv. A letter prepared by the applicant, explaining why they should be considered for a scholarship/ bursary. Should include a review of academic accomplishments, community and parish involvement, and

relevant financial information.
